HALF TERM 4 - Food & Drink [Unit 9]	
Phonics	<b>Sound-Spelling Correspondence [SSC] Focus:</b> Revisit Year 7 SSCs with scheduled phonics retrieval and reinforcement tasks.
Vocabulary & Grammar	<p><b>9.1</b> To recognise and recall a wide variety of food and drink items to say what I eat and drink for my daily meals</p> <p><b>9.2</b> To categorise food and drink into nutritional food groups and use quantifiers to describe my diet in more detail</p> <p><b>9.3</b> To use a variety of appropriate verbs to say what I eat for different meals and give the time</p> <p><b>9.4</b> To understand some cultural differences in France regarding meal times and learn about some typical dishes</p>

Vocabulary & Grammar	<p><b>9.5</b> To express my opinion about food and drink using a range of adjectives, intensifiers and exclamations</p> <p><b>9.6</b> To use topic verbs in up to 3 time frames to say what I ate, usually eat and am going to eat</p> <p><b>9.7</b> To understand a menu and use transactional language to ask questions and order a meal in a restaurant</p>
HALF TERM 6 - Food & Drink [Unit 9] & Shopping [Unit 10]	
Phonics	<b>Sound-Spelling Correspondence [SSC] Focus:</b> Revisit Year 7 SSCs with scheduled phonics retrieval and reinforcement tasks.
Vocabulary & Grammar	<p><b>10.1</b> To say which shops I or we go to and what shops there are in my town</p> <p><b>10.2</b> To use a range of quantities, weights and measures to describe the food/drink products I buy</p> <p><b>10.3</b> To be able to use transactional and polite language to ask for products in a shop</p> <p><b>10.4</b> To say how much pocket money I earn, what chores I do at home to earn it and how often I receive it.</p> <p><b>10.5</b> To use topic verbs in the near future tense to say what I'm going to spend my pocket money on.</p>
