

- Exploration, appreciation, awe and wonder at the beauty of language and reflecting on elements of language that we have in common, and contrasting that with the differences.
- ✓ MFL plays a part in all aspects of liturgy as it demonstrates how countries can be brought together through prayer and worship.
- ✓ Exploring different forms of language and expression.
- ✓ Celebrating the richness and diversity of language and how it gives a sense of identity and belonging to each community.
- ✓ Boosting pupils' self-esteem and sense of achievement as they grow and develop their foreign language vocabulary.
- ✓ Pupils experience a sense of awe and wonder as they recognise that we are part of something much bigger and fostering a respect for our own language, heritage and culture as well as that of other countries.



Moral



- ✓ Explore the moral and social issues and developments of different countries.
- ✓ Misinterpretation of language and subtle meaning may be lost in translation.
- ✓ Debate the advantages and disadvantages of having lots of different languages, or whether there should be one universal language.
- Explore language barriers and how this may affect migration.



Social



- ✓ Celebrate the opportunities that speaking other languages opens up for all people.
- ✓ MFL acquisition is increasingly important in modern society as the need for communication as a global community becomes greater.
- ✓ Learning about the importance of being able to work collaboratively to improve the world without language barriers (e.g through industry, inventions, manufacturing, banking and economy ...)
- ✓ Social skills are developed through group activities and communication exercises.



Cultural



- Exploration, appreciation, awe and wonder at the beauty of language and reflecting on elements of language that we have in common, and contrasting that with the difference.
- Celebrating the richness and diversity of language and how it gives a sense of identity and belonging to each community.
- ✓ Reflect on multi-cultural society that we live in and explore how this is evident in their language
- Demonstrate empathy and understanding of other cultures as they consider the different uses of language and its meaning for different cultures.
- ✓ Building on from the above pupils could consider the impact and influence that this may have on them/others.
- ✓ Develop a sense of tolerance and appreciation of others' beliefs and customs through understanding the language and literature of another country, leading to greater social cohesion.
