

Curriculum Overview – Drama

Drama gives students the opportunity to explore the subject from a range of perspectives: by devising their own, original work; by bringing to life the work of a playwright; as theatre reviewers, developing their own thoughts on what makes drama and theatre successful; and as creative artists building and bringing a character to life through exploration and rehearsal. At GCSE level, students can choose to be assessed as either a performer or as a designer in the non-exam components. This means that students have the choice to complete the course as a performer, as a designer or through a combination of both roles.
